## POSTDOCTORAL FELLOWSHIP

Applications are invited for a research position in the context of the FP7-Regional Potential project "Advancement of Research Capability for the Development of New Functional Compounds" (ARCADE) implemented at the Institute of Organic and Pharmaceutical Chemistry (IOPC) of the National Hellenic Research Foundation, Athens, Greece (www.eie.gr).

The ARCADE project addresses specific focussing on the design and synthesis of functional compounds with potential applications in medicinal chemistry, catalysis and materials science.

A significant part of this project concerns a major upgrade of the Mass Spectrometry facility and we are therefore seeking a researcher with substantial experience in the applications of Mass Spectrometry to the study and characterisation of compounds and materials synthesised in the IOPC. Such compounds range from low molecular weight organic compounds to metal coordination compounds and dendrimers. As well as carrying out her/his own research project the researcher will also be expected to provide transfer of knowledge in mass spectrometry techniques to the other members of the IOPC.

The post will commence from September 2010 and will initially be for a period of one year with the possibility of renewal. The maximum duration of the appointment will be 30 months.
