BIOGRAPHY — PROFESSOR JOHN POLANYI

John Charles Polanyi, educated at Manchester University, England, and Princeton University is a faculty member in the Department of Chemistry at the University of Toronto and a member of the Queen's Privy Council for Canada. His awards include the 1986 Nobel Prize in Chemistry, the Royal Medal of the Royal Society of London, and some thirty honorary degrees from six countries. He has written extensively on science policy, the control of armaments, human rights, and peacekeeping.
