Farewell event in honor of Dr. Josef Puchta, Former Director of the German Center for Cancer Research (DKFZ) & Member of the International Scientific Committee of the Athens Comprehensive Cancer Center (ACCC), NHRF

On Friday 29th November 2019, in Heidelberg, Germany, a farewell symposium was held in honor of **Dr. Josef Puchta**, the Former Director of the **German Cancer Research Center (DKFZ)**. Dr. Josef Puchta reached the legal retirement, after more than 23 years of crucial contribution to the Center's management, which has been evolved to one of the largest and most innovative organizations in the world thanks to Dr. Puchta.

Dr. Josef Puchta was a founding member of the International Scientific Committee of the **Athens Comprehensive Cancer Center (ACCC)**, a major initiative of the **NHRF** in collaboration with the DKFZ for the personalized and holistic treatment of cancer in Greece.

Ursula Weyrich who succeeds Dr. Josef Puchta has long experience in managing highly complex and international organizations. Ursula Weyrich, among others, is co-founder of the German Center for Neurodegenerative Diseases, a leading bioscience organization.

Dr. Puchta, in his farewell speech, emphasized: "I have known Ursula Weyrich for many years as an excellent and highly esteemed colleague and I am certain that she will help develop DKFZ. After more than 23 extremely interesting and challenging years, this certainty makes it easier for me to take my leave. I wish my successor every success in her new tasks."



The **NHRF** Director & Chairman of the Board and ACCC's Administrative Director, **Dr. Vasilis Gregoriou**, attended the event and said during his speech: "A vision of years for the National Hellenic Research Foundation has taken shape in Greece, thanks to the full support and special enthusiasm of Dr. Josef Puchta. to the **Athens Comprehensive Cancer Center (ACCC)** whose core is the interdisciplinary approach to the holistic cancer treatment. I'm sure that Dr. Puchta will remain a valuable consultant in any future development step of ACCC."

Researchers from the Athens Center have already developed new diagnostic and prognostic tests, analyzing and utilizing response predictions in individualized therapies and also they are working on the development of new chemical drugs. ACCC is an initiative of the National Hellenic Research Foundation (NHRF) with a vision of diagnosing and treating patients in Athens and gradually across Greece.
